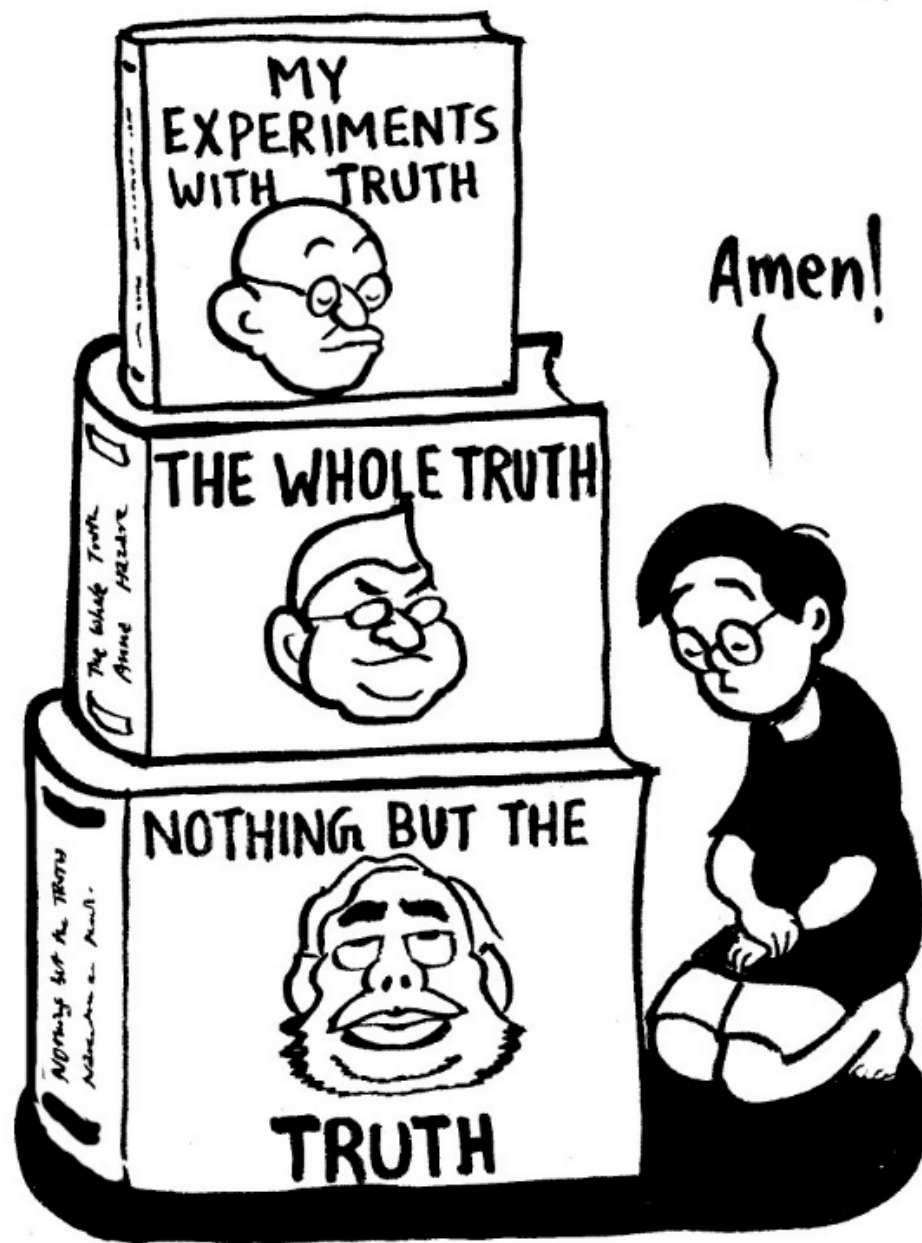

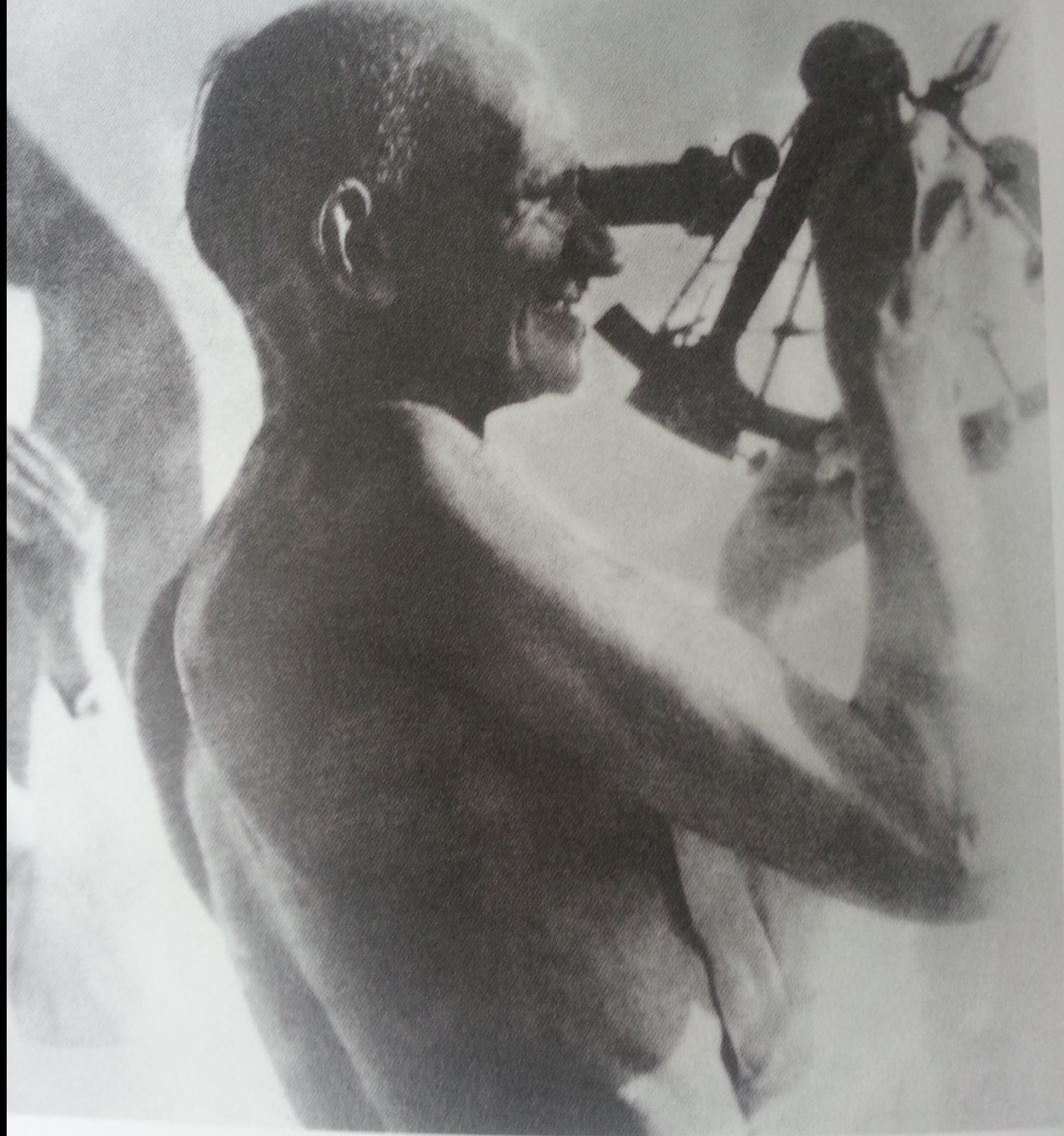


Gandhi was a severe critic of Modern Civilization, not of science and scientific method.

Gandhi did not condemn the scientific temper of the west. He objected to the use of scientific discoveries against Humanity.

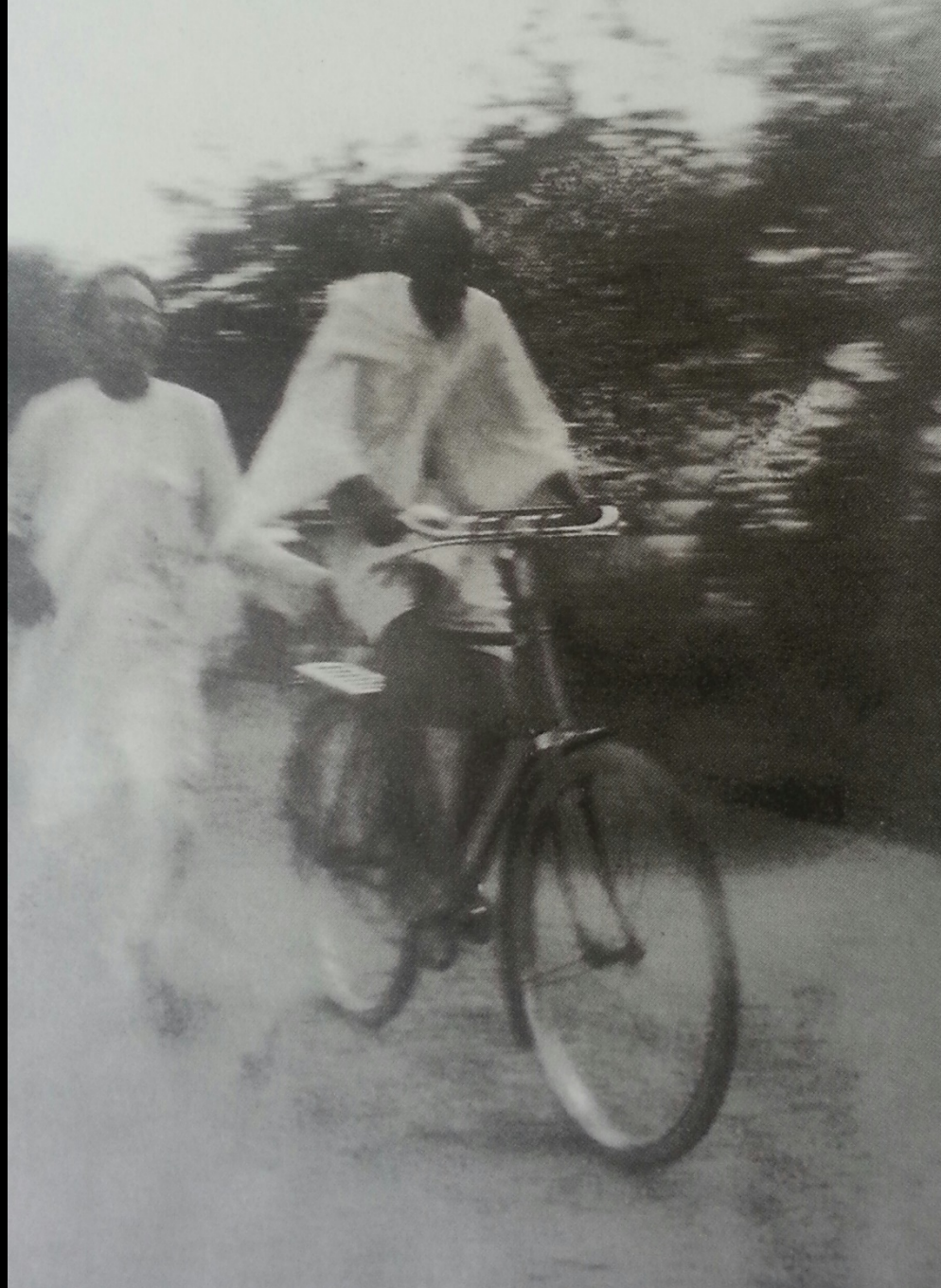

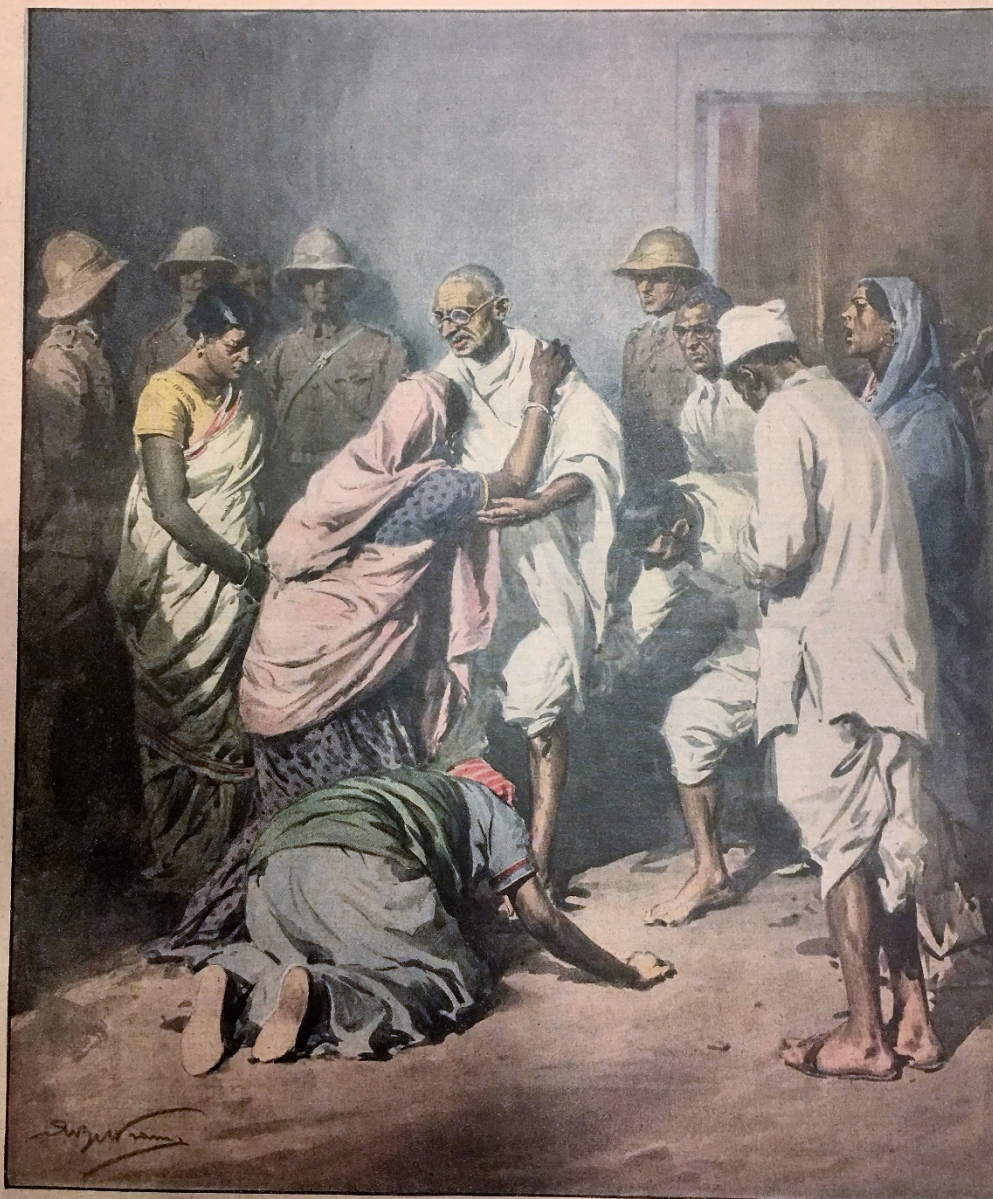

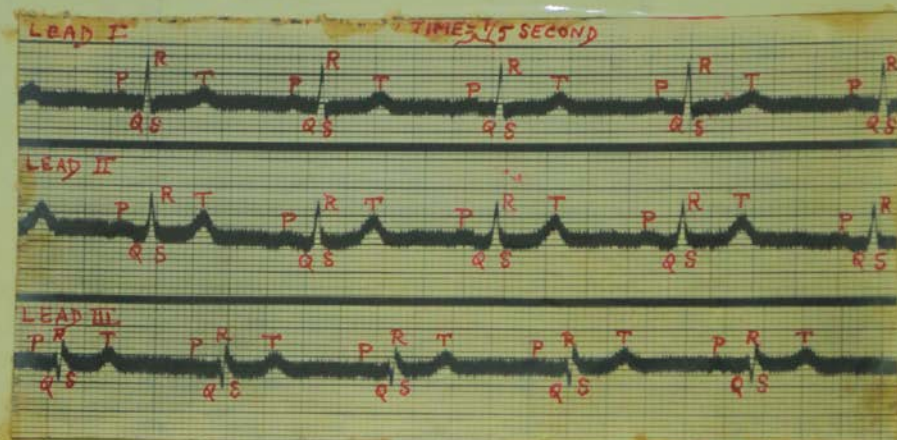




Report of Electro-Cardio-Graphic
Examination of Mahatma Gandhi

CASE NO : 2070.

Oct. 28th., 1937.



NOTE :-

From P to Q, is the contraction of the Auricles : or, the " Auricular Complex ".

From Q-R-S to T, ending at T, is the contraction of the Ventricles : or, the
" Ventricular Complex ".

From T to the next P, is the interval of " Diastole ".

ELECTRO-CARDIO-GRAM POINTS :-

1. E. C. G. shows - myocardium in fairly good order.
2. Probably, a tendency towards slight degree of Left Ventricular Preponderance; that is, the Left Ventricle has slightly more Hypertrophy than the Right Ventricle.
3. No evidence of gross organic changes in the Heart-Muscle, nor any Coronary Artery lesion.
4. P-R interval is 0.16 second : " High-Normal ".
5. The main A-V Bundle of His is normal as regards structure and function.
6. The Right and Left Bundle Branches are also normal.
7. Heart-Rate at rest is 72 per minute: Rhythm is regular.

COMPARISON with E. C. G. of 17th. July, 1934:

The present Tracing shows points of improvement in the Myocardial condition as compared with that taken over 3 years ago.
